During the month of April the Menifee Union School District Governing Board took the following actions: Approved an Agreement for Recycled Water Retrofit Funding, by and between Eastern Municipal Water District and Menifee Union School District for Callie Kirkpatrick Elementary School and Bell Mountain Middle School; declared the week of May 16-20, 2016 as Week of the Classified Employee; declared Wednesday, May 11, 2016 as Day of The Teacher; approved the Agreement between Hemet Unified School District (HUSD) and Menifee Union School District(MUSD) for the lease of Menifee school buses; authorized the utilization of National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO), through SIGMAnet, Inc., for licensing and configuration services for 3,488 Chromebook computers for District-wide use.
