Our Governing Board in Action

During the month of April the Menifee Union School District Governing Board took the following actions: Held a special meeting for a Mid-Year Review of Governing Board Goals; received the Curriculum/Survey results; awarded contracts for the construction of ES #14; ratified the agreement between Menifee Union School District and CR&R, Inc. for collection and disposal services; approved a contract with Sunesys, LLC to build a high-speed private fiber backbone network to all school sites in the District which will provide the District with fast, highly secure connectivity between all sites and the District Office; declared the week of May 15-19, 2017 as Week of the Classified Employee; declared May 10, 2017 as Day of the Teacher; approved a three (3) year Software Agreement between Menifee Union School District and OpenGov, Inc. that will provide a public facing software platform that allows the District to make reports public to the school community, board members, and district stakeholders which will allow for greater transparency in District spending as well as provide non-financial data in the areas of attendance, facilities planning, and test scores.

Presentations

Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum, Dr. Karen Valdes lead a presentation during the special study session that focused on the Units of Study and the teacher survey results, with a goal of looking at the vision of cultivating a community of 21st century learning.

Dr. Ekaterina Forrester from Key Data Systems presented the results of the teacher survey, and stated that the purpose of the survey was to provide actionable information to the Curriculum & Instruction Department about the design and implementation of the curriculum in the district.

A 21 item online survey was administered to all ELA and Mathematics teachers across MUSD. A total of 365 elementary and middle school teachers from three middle schools and ten elementary schools in the district participated.

Dr. Valdes, Mr. Regus, Mr. Chitwood and Ms. Frye followed with a presentation on the Units of Study and the CA Dashboard data.

It was agreed by the Superintendent and Governing Board that the best instructional materials and curriculum, that will ensure a world class education for all MUSD students is the priority.
