During the month of August the Menifee Union School District Governing Board took the following actions: approved a Lease Agreement between the Menifee Union School District and the Menifee Historical Association; ratified a contract with Alta Inspection Services for the Chester W. Morrison Elementary School Fire Alarm Upgrade Project; approved an Agreement for Services between After School Enrichment Programs (ASEP) and the Menifee Union School District to provide Gifted and Talented Education (GATE) enrichment at participating school sites. Classes will be held during the regular school day, provided by After School Enrichment Programs.
