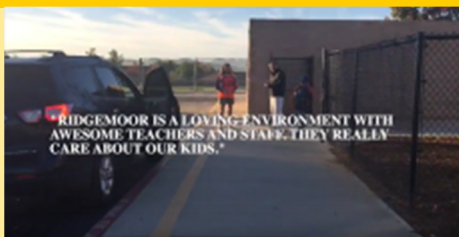

During the month of December the Menifee Union School District Governing Board took the following actions: appointed Marc Haist, a parent/guardian of a child enrolled in the District AND active in a parent-teacher organization to the District's Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee for Measure Q; accepted the 2016-2017 Annual Report for the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee for Measure Q as presented; accepted the independent financial audit for fiscal year ending June 30, 2017; accepted the independent audit report of the General Obligation Bonds, Series A (Measure Q) for the period ending June 30, 2017; approved the School Innovation & Achievement Addendum to include additional elements and in depth reporting regarding subgroups within Menifee Union School District at no additional cost to the District; approved travel and related conference expenses to attend the National School Board Association Conference in San Antonio, Texas; accepted the Menifee Council of Classified Employees Sunshine Proposal for 2017 to 2020; elected Mr. Ron Ulibarri as Board President, Mr. Reg Bennett as VP, Dr. Randy Freeman as Clerk, Mr. Jerry Bowman as Deputy Clerk and Mr. Robert O'Donnell as Member.
