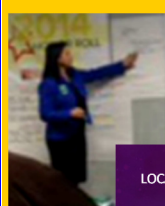

During the month of February, the Menifee Union School District Governing Board took the following actions: ratified the contract with Sunesys, to provide fiber network solutions between the District Education Center and sites to accommodate additional bandwidth requirements; ratified the contract with SEHI Computer Products, Inc. to provide Network Electronics; accepted the Menifee Union School District Sunshine Proposal for 2015/16 Negotiations with Menifee Teachers Association, and the MUSD Classified Union; approved the appointment of the following Administrative positions, Mr. Sergio Reyes Gonzales as Principal of Freedom Crest Elementary School effective Feb. 24, 2016, and Mrs. Sandy Vilas as Principal of Southshore, effective May, 16 2016.
