**The Governing Board accepted with thanks the following donations:**

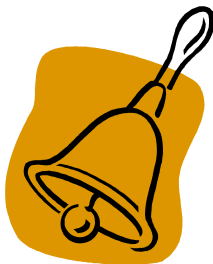
