Our Governing Board in Action

During the month of January the Menifee Union School District Governing Board took the following actions: declared items obsolete; accepted donations, with a value of \$1,891.34; received the Williams Settlement Quarterly Uniform Complaint Report 2nd Quarter 2016/17; ratified a letter on school information for tracts located in the subdivision Audie Murphy Ranch; adopted Resolution No. 2017-58 declaring February 2017 as Black History Month; accepted additional donations, with a retail value of \$34,628.00.

Presentations

Callie Kirkpatrick Principal, Ms. Lynn Hanke presented a School Snapshot, highlighting many of the incredible activities happening at their school, including plans for student and community engagement to ensure a bright future for all CKE students.



Facilities Director, Mr. Bruce Shaw, provided clarification for why the District has entered into a negotiated agreement that provides a cost per square foot for the development that provides money to the District for pupil housing needs. It will provide capital to finance facilities necessary to support increase in population, as it pertains to a potential school in a new development.



The Knights of Columbus Grand Knight, Mr. Stephen Gaston, Deputy Grand Knight, Mr. George Toscano and Financial Secretary, Mr. Michael Castillejos presented a check for \$334.18, 1/3 of the total funds raised during their October Fundraising drive for the Intellectually Disabled.
