Our Governing Board in Action

During the month of June the Menifee Union School District Governing Board took the following actions: approved an updated cost estimate with WLC Architects for services on the Harvest Hill STEAM Academy K-8 Conversion; approved an updated cost estimate with Neff Construction for construction management services on the Harvest Hill STEAM Academy K-8 Conversion; approved RCOE IN30321 Agreement for Audiological Services; approved the Agreement for Data Services with Key Data Systems; ratified the Amendment to the Independent Contractor Agreement with Summit Speech Pathology Services, Inc.; adopted Resolution No. 2018-69 ordering consolidated governing board member biennial election; approve the 2018-2019 Single Plans for Student Achievement for all District schools; approved the Master Services Agreement with IO Education; approved the agreement with the Assistance League of Temecula Valley for participation in its Operation School Bell program; approved award of bid for the 2018/2019 school year for Gold Star Foods to provide Fresh and Processed Produce.

Presentations

Mrs. Cindy Woods, Assistant Superintendent, Curriculum & Instruction presented an LCAP (Local Control Accountability Plan) Overview. Mrs. Woods shared an overview of stakeholder input and the main pieces of LCAP.

The greatest progress demonstrated is English Learner progress. Reclassification rates increased due to teacher training, strategies that are most helpful for staffing and learning, the adopted new reclassification guidelines and now included reclassification criteria for kindergartners and first graders. Reduced chronic absenteeism and suspension rates. Family engagement is big part of success. Mrs. Woods added that Mr. Joel Hood, has trained site administrators, district team and teachers on social emotional learning strategies.

Mr. Brian Martes, Principal of Harvest Hill STEAM Academy, presented some of the uniform pieces that the HHSA students will wear beginning in the 2018-19 school year.
