Our Governing Board in Action

During the month of November the Menifee Union School District Governing Board took the following actions: approved Resolution No. 2018-41: Supplemental Early Retirement Program (SERP) for eligible employees, (The SERP Program is an early retirement incentive designed to: 1.) address budget deficits; 2.) assist in proactive staffing planning; 3.) enhance retiree benefits; and 4.) reward long-term employees, the District will make a final determination of savings based upon participation; approved the agreement for PSAT Subsidy with Riverside County Superintendent of School; approved a five (5) year Service Agreement with Bay Alarm Company to provide burglar alarm monitoring for ES#14; approved the purchase of one 2018 Ford Escape SUV; awarded Bid No. 18-003 for District Wide Landscape Maintenance to Bill & Dave's Landscape Maintenance, Inc.; approved the Menifee Union School District Annual and Five-Year reports for 2016-17, Developer Impact Fees as prepared by Cooperative Strategies, LLC.

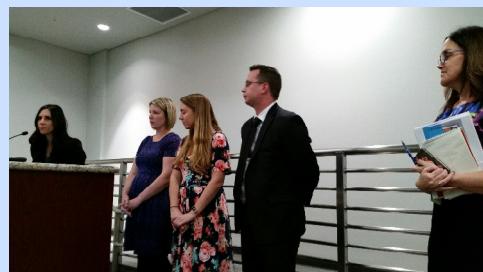
MUSD School Counseling Department
