During the month of October the Menifee Union School District Governing Board took the following actions: Approved budget adjustments to the General Fund with a net zero impact to the operating surplus/(deficit); approved a Notice of Authorization with Cooperative Strategies, LLC to provide consulting services to assist in facilitating the school attendance boundary committee for ES #14 and MS #4; ratified the 2017/18 California State Preschool Program Contract; approved District/School membership in associations, organizations and societies for 2017-18, which has for its purpose the advancement of education or the betterment of educational opportunities for children.
