Increased Enrollment at MUSD Schools

The Next Step for MUSD Schools

Since the State does not provide adequate funding for school facilities projects, the MUSD Governing Board voted to place Measure R, a \$205 million facilities improvement bond measure on the November 2024 ballot. Measure R would be limited to \$30 dollars per \$100,000 of assessed value (not market value).

If approved by voters, funds from Measure R could:

- Add schools and classrooms to help address increased student enrollment
- Support quality instruction in math, science, technology, engineering, and arts
- Remove hazardous materials where needed
- Repair or replace deteriorating roofs, plumbing, sewer, heating, ventilation, and electrical systems
- Ensure all schools meet current academic and safety standards
- Provide proper access for students with disabilities
- Add classrooms to support full day TK and K instruction

Required Fiscal Accountability

Measure R requires a clear system of accountability including:

- Citizens' oversight and independent audits to ensure funds are spent on approved projects
- All money raised by Measure R would remain under local control
- No funds could be taken by the State
- Funds from Measure R could be used to compete for State matching funds that would otherwise go to other school districts
